Dear Dave:

A Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request was received from you by the Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority on July 13, 2014 in which you requested:


We hereby request all records that include any documentation of the following:

- (1) That the DDA board has specified the performance review of the DDA executive director as one of its duties.
- (2) That the DDA board has specified recommendations on the DDA executive director's salary as one of its duties.

Your request is denied because the DDA is not in possession of the documents you requested.

In the event you do not believe that appropriate response has been made to your request, you may either submit an appeal specifically containing the word "appeal" to the DDA board, the head of the public body, identifying the reason for your appeal, or you may seek judicial relief pursuant to Section 10 of FOIA. Section 10 provides that attorney's fees and damages may be available to you if your judicial appeal is successful.
