I have not included the 4-Party Agreement on the March 5 Council agenda. The AATA finance committee/workgroup is meeting February 29. The AATA has scheduled a public informational drop-in session for March 2.

On February 6, Council directed:

A motion was made by Councilmember Higgins, seconded by Councilmember Teall, to amend the amendment to postpone the Resolution until 3/5/2012 with the following condition:

Contingent upon materials being submitted to City Council by 2/29/12.

I do not believe the intent of Council's motion is met by AATA providing material late on the 29th and prior to the public information session on the 2nd.

Scheduling the 4-Party Agreement for a later date may also provide opportunity for information regarding the regional transit bill's impact on Ann Arbor and a forecast of the bill's future.

Per Council Rule, the agenda has been sent to the Administration Committee for review. Unless the Administration Committee believes the 4-Party Agreement should be on the March 5 agenda, I will tell the AATA it has time to prepare the financial information, including the public input, for consideration by Council.
