**Gift of Life Michigan Medical Examiner Fee Schedule**

*MEs will be reimbursed for the following services:*

**\$25** Draw and label donor blood/vitreous specimens for donor testing.

**\$50** Autopsy reports provided to Gift of Life 60 to 90 days after the donor's death.

**\$75** Autopsy reports provided to Gift of Life within 59 days after the donor's death.

**\$75** Adjustment to medical examiner's autopsy schedule to allow tissue recover to begin within 24 hours of donor's death or last-seen-alive time.

**\$75** Investigator or law enforcement observation of surgical recovery at a donor facility.

**\$100** Forensic photography of an organ or tissue donor at a donor facility.

**\$350** Medical examiner aseptic examination of donor organs or tissue at a donor facility.

**Actual cost** Transportation of the body to or from donor surgical site.

## I. PURPOSE

To standardize and set guidelines for assuring timely payments for medical examiner services and permits.

## II. APPLICATION

This policy applies to the Washtenaw County Medical Examiner program of the Washtenaw County Public Health Department (WCPHD)

## III. POLICY

The Washtenaw County Medical Examiner program will assess late fees to accounts that aren't paid in full by end of the credit period.

## IV. DEFINITIONS

**CREDIT PERIOD** THE CREDIT PERIOD IS 30 CALENDAR DAYS FROM THE ISSUED DATE OF THE ORIGINAL INVOICE.

**LATE FEE** A LATE FEE OF 5% WILL BE CHARGED IF PAYMENT IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN 30 CALENDAR DAYS OF THE ISSUED DATE ON THE ORIGINAL INVOICE.

## V. PROCEDURES

All agencies must pay charges in accordance with the terms established by Washtenaw County Government, the credit period is thirty (30) calendar days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, and shall begin on the day the invoice is issued following the presentation of the cremation permit.

Agencies that do not pay within the thirty (30) calendar days will be assessed a late fee of 5% of the entire past due invoice amount.

Should an agency have any outstanding invoices in arrears of ninety (90) calendar days, a hold will be placed on all permit requests. The agency will be required to bring their account current prior to any future cremation permits being issued.

Outstanding balances will be reviewed with the finance manager and the accounts receivable specialist on a quarterly basis. Delinquent notices shall be sent on those accounts past due per the credit policy. Delinquent unpaid balances over one hundred and twenty (120) calendar days may be referred to a collection agency or civil court. The agency shall be put on a cash basis until a satisfactory credit statement can be provided. Any collection and/or legal fees assessed during this process will be the sole responsibility of the agency that is past due.

Collection agency and / or civil court action will revoke any previous credit authorized. Future permit / service requests will be processed on a cash basis. Meaning, payment must accompany all future permit / service requests.
