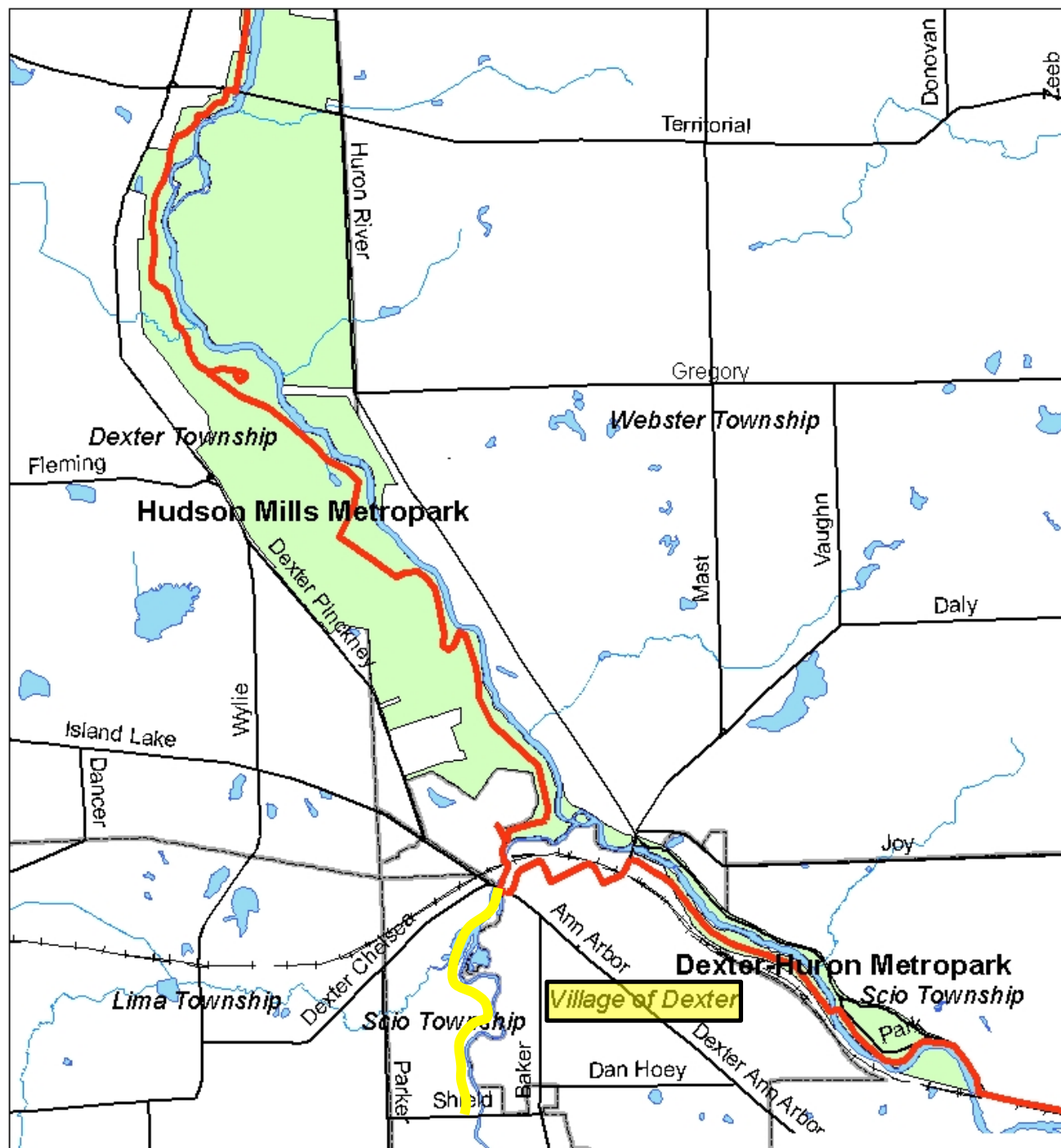
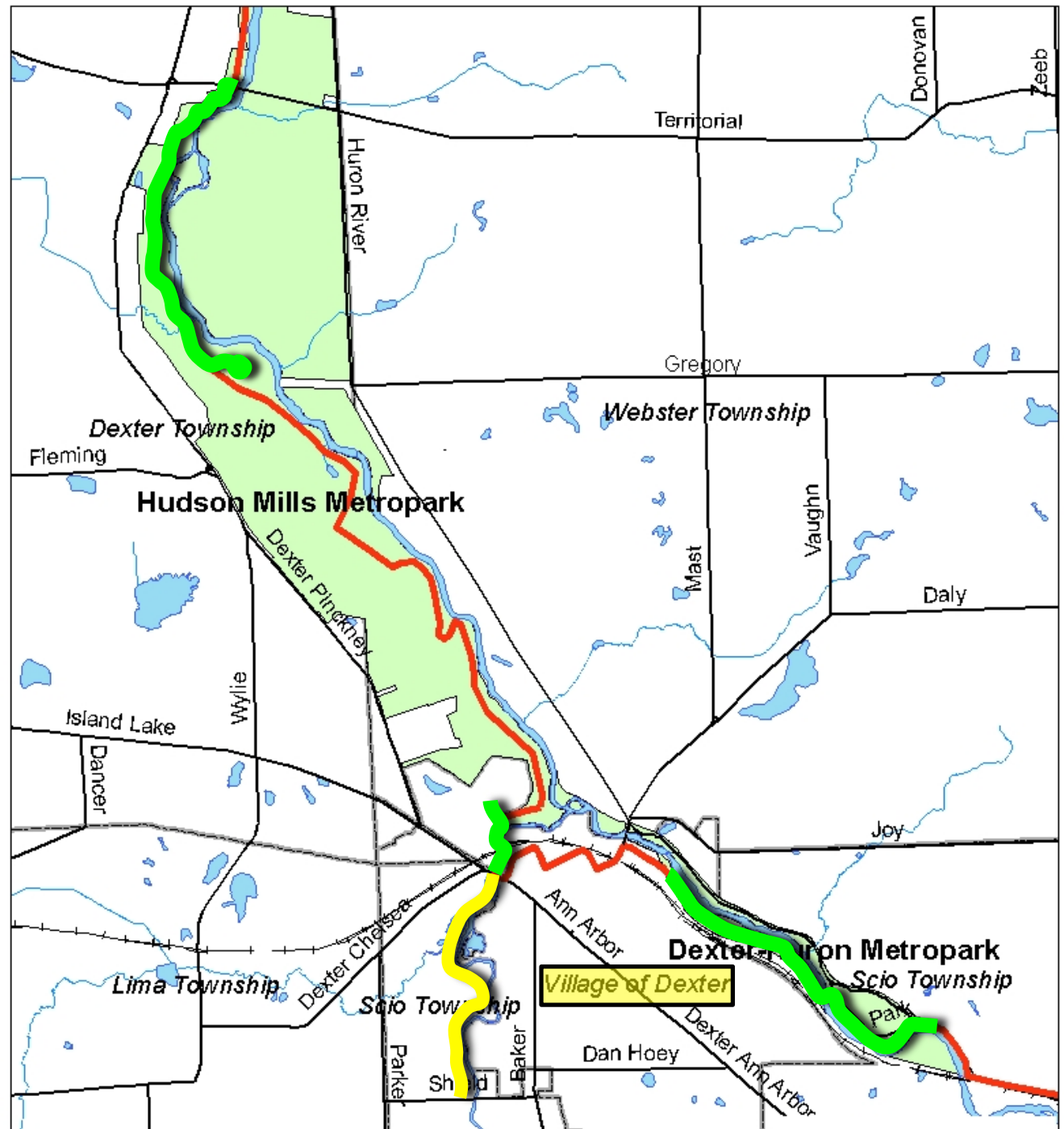


Dexter Area B2B – segments C and D1

A BORDER-TO-BORDER TRAIL PROJECT



COMING SOON... The Washington County Parks & Recreation Commission (WPCARC), in partnership with the Huron/Civilian Metroparks, is constructing a 1.42 mile nonmotorized trail segment from Dexter-Huron Metropark to the Dexter Village limits. The first phase of the project (where you are now standing) includes a pedestrian bridge crossing the Huron River and 0.33 miles of asphalt trail and boardwalk. The remainder of the project is anticipated to be completed by the spring of 2013.



The B2B Trail:

- Provides conservation and access to the Huron River corridor
- Provides opportunities for nonmotorized transportation, recreation, river access, and links to neighboring counties
- is now halfway completed (approximately 18 miles)

During the construction of this B2B segment, WPCARC and its partners have made environmental sensitivity a priority to preserve the natural beauty of the river.

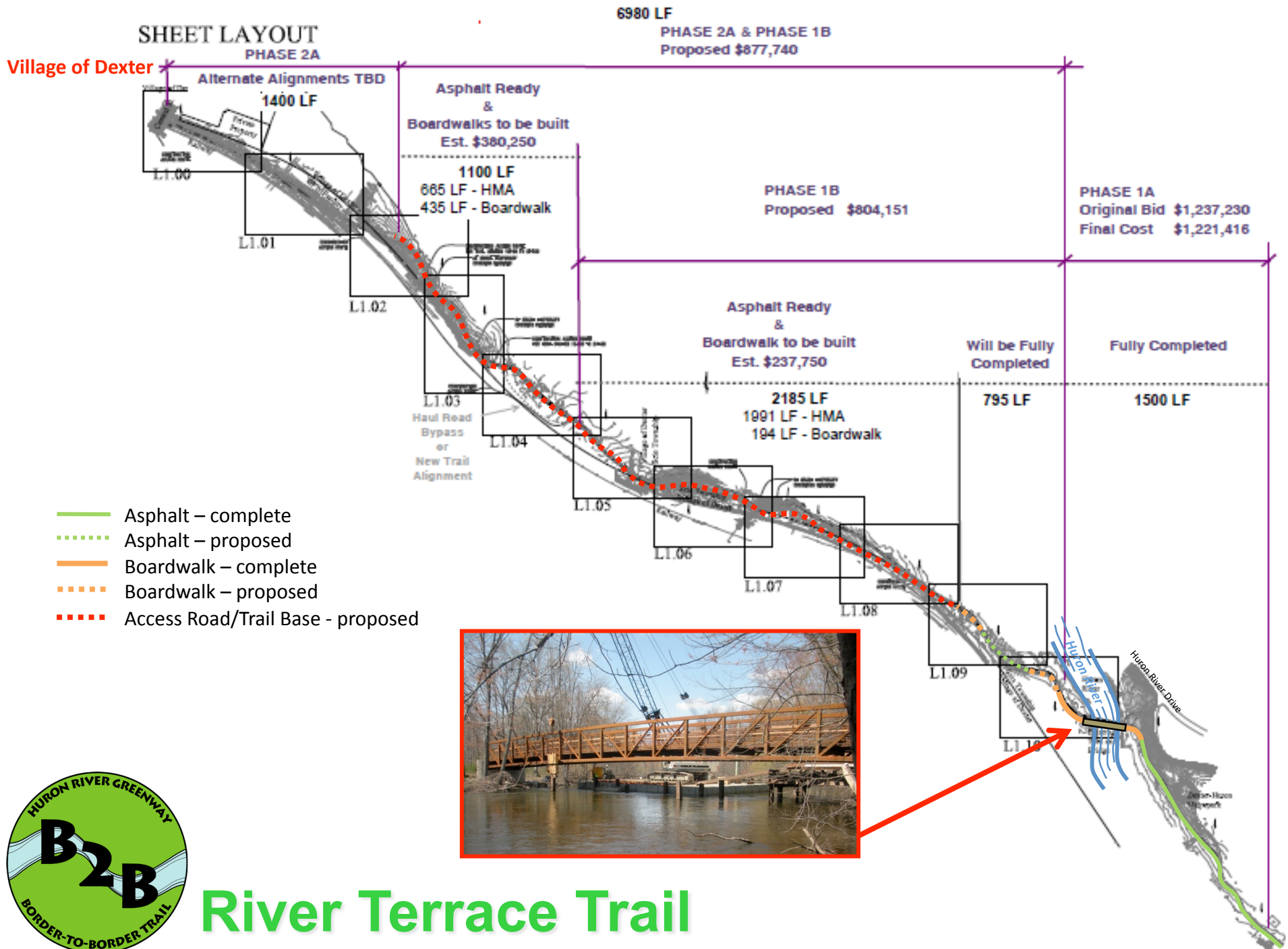
