The Ann Arbor District Library has classified its employees into two classifications:

Regular Employees – These employees work a standard schedule every week and are eligible to participate in the benefit programs that are offered by the Library. Many organizations refer to this classification as "Full-Time" employees, but we also have a couple of employees that are only regularly scheduled for 20 hours a week and not the traditional 40 hours. In order to avoid the confusion of "Full-Time" employees that only work 20 hours, we refer to them as "Regular Employees".

Casual Employees - These employees are scheduled between 16 and 19 hours each week. Many organizations refer to this classification of employees as "Part-Time" employees, but due to the same rationale as stated above we refer to them as "Casual Employees". This classification of employee is not eligible to participate in any of the benefit programs offered to the "Regular Employees".
