
Dear Ms. Fink,

Thank you for your letter dated February 9, 2014 in which you conveyed the concerns of the Ann Arbor Chronicle that the Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority had violated the Open Meetings Act by not posting its monthly Executive Committee meetings, including the meeting at which the DDA Executive Director's annual evaluation was discussed.

Attached is a copy of a meeting notice that has been posted at Ann Arbor City Hall and at the Ann Arbor DDA office stating the time and place at which the Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority's Executive Committee would be meeting throughout 2014. These meetings are clearly noted as taking place at 11:00 a.m. at the Ann Arbor DDA office before the monthly DDA meeting on the meeting date listed. A similar meeting notice was posted for previous years as well.

It is our belief that this meeting notice is in full compliance with the Open Meetings Act as it provides clear notice when the DDA Executive Committee meetings would be taking place.

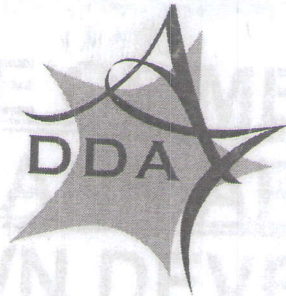
