

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING ADMINISTRATION TO ENGAGE IN EXPEDITED
NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE UNIONS

WHEREAS, on December, 2012, Governor Rick Snyder signed "Right to Work" legislation, which was passed in the 96th session of the Michigan Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County has long had a beneficial relationship with labor unions representing our County workforce.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners seeks to continue the long and successful partnerships the County, its businesses, organizations, and citizens have had with various labor organizations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners directs the County Administrator and the Director of Human Resources to engage in expedited negotiations, as requested by the Unions.
