PROJECT NAME: Scio-Church Street fence

Location: Fence along new sidewalk and 94 bridge embankment; Delaware to Maple, Lawton neighborhood

Description of Project:

Creative, unique design, to be incorporated into, or can be functional as, a new fence along a new sidewalk. The new sidewalk was petitioned to be built by residents in the area. Walk is scheduled to be completed FY14 or 15. The location for the sidewalk is the south side of Scio-Church Street, east of Maple—in the Lawton neighborhood.

Goals and Expectations of the Project:

Coordinate the fence with the construction of the walk. Beautify the neighborhood with creative, aesthetic application to a functional street element.

Evaluation of Criteria:

Quadrant/ City Area: South city area, does not have any public artworks

High Use/ Visibility: 6410 Avg. Annual Daily Traffic, second highest traffic among potential projects

Underserved: What Associated Need is Targeted, the Improved Aesthetics of the Space, or the Opportunity for Placemaking?

The new sidewalk was requested by the community. This walk will connect the neighborhood with shopping, sports and library west of the highway. Project is an aesthetic consideration for functional infrastructure that is community supported.
