Street lighting improvements at Eastern Michigan University and City of Ypsilanti

EMU improvements (both installation and operation/maintenance will be paid by EMU):

- 6 new lights will be installed on Clark Road, west of Leforge Road.
- 8 new lights will be installed on Clark Road, east of Leforge Road.
- Several (exact # TBD) new pedestrian-level lights will be installed along the south side of Huron River Dr. between Westview and Gregory, and again from Cornell to Mayhew.
- 6 new lights will be added on the north side of Huron River Dr., between Leforge and Mayhew.
- 3 existing lights at Huron River Dr. and Westview (near Westview Apartments) will be upgraded to LED.
- Existing street lights on Westview will be replaced with brighter LED assemblies (LED is brighter, less costly, and better for the environment).
- 8 lights at Fletcher School, will be upgraded to LED.
- 4 new lights will be added to the west side of Cornell, north of Fletcher School, up to Huron River Drive.
- 5 new lights will be added on the west side of Cornell AT Fletcher School.
- Replacing several existing lights on Oakwood, south of Huron River Dr., that have failed or are failing.

City of Ypsilanti improvements

- 3 City-owned lights at Huron River Dr. and Leforge intersection will be upgraded to LED.
- 7-8 City-owned lights on Leforge will be upgraded to LED.
- The City is upgrading all of its lights throughout the City to LED. This is a massive project involving hundreds of lights.
